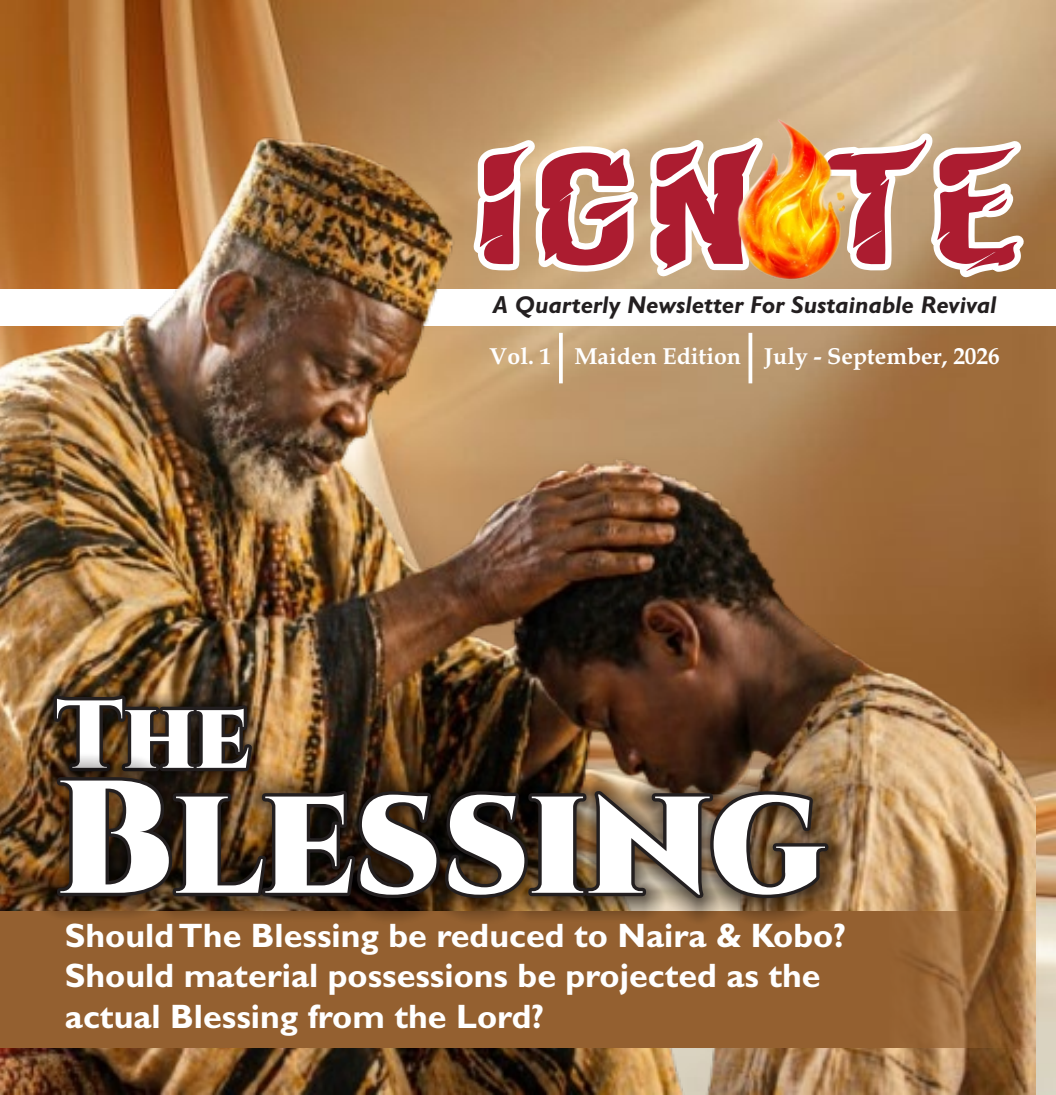

THE BLESSING

Should The Blessing be reduced to Naira and Kobo? Should material possessions be projected as the true Blessing from the Lord?

"And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion..." Genesis 1:28

Let me conclude before I begin - **The Blessing is not merely material provision; it is divine impartation for dominion and destiny fulfillment.**

The Blessing is the supernatural empowerment of God that causes a man to prevail in life. It is more of a spiritual substance than a material possession. The Blessing carries the power that enables a person to rise above limitations, make progress against all odds, and succeed despite opposition. Material things may accompany it, but they are not its essence.

Let me be more practical. Consider a person preparing for a major journey or planning a life-defining venture — perhaps marriage, a career, a business, or even a political pursuit. When such a person goes to father figures or elders to ask for their blessing, what exactly are they seeking? Is it money or material possessions? Certainly not. They are seeking something deeper and greater - a spiritual advantage, divine approval, and supernatural backing. I call it an unfair advantage. That is The Blessing. Some spiritually intelligent politicians understand this reality. That is why, during election seasons, they go to

royal fathers who are believed to be custodians of certain dimensions of spiritual substance and ancestral authority, to seek that advantage and backing.

Unfortunately, many people today have trivialized these sacred moments and divine protocols. Some of these politicians even go as far as offering money to entice those father figures in order to secure their backing. This reveals how much value people with spiritual intelligence place on spiritual advantage, even when they may not fully understand its true essence.

On the contrary, many children no longer understand the value and how to position themselves for the Blessing. Their eyes are fixed more on the material possessions of their parents than on the Blessing itself. They have lost the discernment to recognize these Kairos moments - moments when destinies can be shaped through divine impartation.

The Blessing is spiritual before it becomes visible. It flows through words, covenants, obedience, honour, and divine impartation. This is why the patriarchs in Scripture valued The Blessing above silver and gold. They understood that material wealth can be lost, but The Blessing carries the power to recreate wealth, restore honour, and establish destiny.

"Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and

the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine: Let people serve thee, and nations bow down to thee: be lord over thy brethren... cursed be every one that curseth thee, and blessed be he that blesseth thee” Genesis 27:28-29

“And Isaac answered and said unto Esau, Behold, I have made him thy lord, and all his brethren have I given to him for servants; and with corn and wine have I sustained him: and what shall I do now unto thee, my son?” Genesis 27:37

That is why Esau sought it with tears; he became bitter enough to desire the death of Jacob, who had gone away with The Blessing.

“For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.” Hebrews 12:17

“And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him...” Genesis 27:41-42

Notice carefully: the physical possessions of Isaac - who was one of the wealthiest men of his generation - were not the real issue of contention. The struggle was over The Blessing - that moment of divine impartation which guarantees every good thing in life beyond material possessions.

Today, many children disrespect and despise their parents simply because they lack visible wealth. But no matter the material inheritance received from a father, it can eventually finish. However, when inheritance is accompanied by The Blessing, it establishes a man.

Consider also the prodigal son. He demanded material inheritance from his wealthy father, but because the inheritance was received without the

blessing and goodwill of the father, he went and squandered everything.

And the younger of them said to his father, Father, give me the portion of goods that falleth to me. And he divided unto them his living. And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living.” Luke 15:12-13

The Blessing is not in Naira & Kobo; it is the supernatural empowerment of God that causes a man to prevail in life.

Friends, these things operate by seasons and timings. “To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven.” - Ecclesiastes 3:1

Moments for the release of The Blessing do not occur every day. They come in appointed seasons. If a person is not spiritually sensitive, responsible, and available, such moments may be lost for a lifetime.

We must therefore become intentional about recognizing seasons, sacred moments, divine opportunities, and even the channels through which The Blessing can flow. Then we must position ourselves rightly and responsibly to receive it.

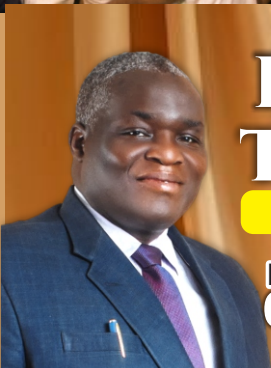
